“Stewarding our Time”

Day 1

Prayer Focus:

Ask the Holy Spirit for guidance in using the time you're given this year wisely.

Scripture:

“Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom.”

Prayer Focus:

Make the most of the time we have.

Scripture:

“Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes.”

James 4:14

Prayer Focus:

Make time spent with Jesus in fellowship a priority.

Scripture:

“Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me. “I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.”

John 15:4-5

Day 4

Prayer Focus:

Jesus made prayer and quiet times with the Father a priority. So should we.

Scripture:

“But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed.”

Luke 5:16

Day 5

Prayer Focus:

Wake up; put God first; His light is coming!

Scripture:

“And do this, understanding the present time: The hour has already come for you to wake up from your slumber, because our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed. The night is nearly over; the day is almost here. So let us put aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light.”

Romans 13:11-12

“Stewarding our Relationships”

Day 6

Prayer Focus:

Carry the burdens of each other and support one another within the community of New Covenant

Scripture:

“Carry each other’s burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.”

Galatians 6:2

Day 7

Prayer Focus:

Pray for healing and forgiveness in our relationships, focusing primarily on restoration, letting go of past hurts, and forgiving each other.

Scripture:

“Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.”

Colossians 3:13

Notes:

Day 8

Prayer Focus:

Pray for unity of mind and unity of focus, and that God will lead us into a place of revival.

Scriptures:

“Finally, all of you, be like-minded, be sympathetic, love one another, be compassionate and humble.”

1 Peter 3:8

Day 9

Prayer Focus:

Pray for the church to grow.

1. Pray for opportunities to invite others to church
2. Look for opportunities to pray with other for their needs
3. Bringing more individuals into the community of New Covenant

Scripture:

“My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one’s life for one’s friends.”

John 15:12-13

Notes:

Day 10

Prayer Focus:

Pray for an attitude of repentance

Scripture:

“Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.”

James 5:16

Notes:

“Stewarding our Gifts”

Day 11

Prayer Focus:

Pray that you know your gifts, are grateful for them and are using them to bless others. If not, ask God to help you steward your gifts this year.

Scripture:

“Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God’s grace in its various forms.”

1 Peter 4:10

Notes:

Day 12

Prayer Focus:

Pray for a greater hunger for fellowship and intimacy with Jesus, knowing that you can trust God to take care of the other concerns in life.

Scripture:

“But seek first His Kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.”

Matthew 6:33

Notes:

Day 13

Prayer Focus:

Recognize that the spiritual gifts we have been entrusted with:

1. Are opportunities to use those gifts for the Kingdom
2. Are given to us to use, not lie dormant
3. Aren't the only gifts available to us - ask Jesus for more!

Scripture:

“Do not neglect your gift, which was given you through prophecy when the body of elders laid their hands on you.”

1 Timothy 4:14

Notes:

Day 14

Prayer Focus:

Pray for your Pastors and those in leadership in the church. Ask the Holy Spirit to give them fresh revelation, focused vision and the heart of a shepherd.

Scripture:

“This, then, is how you ought to regard us: as servants of Christ and as those entrusted with the mysteries God has revealed.”

1 Corinthians 4:1

Notes:

Day 15

Prayer Focus:

Accept the fact that God approves of you! Regardless of your shortcomings, He believes in you! Now, go forward with that knowledge and pray for the Holy Spirit to show you how His word applies to your life.

Scriptures:

“Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth.”

2 Timothy 2:15

Notes:

“Stewarding our Money”

Day 16

Prayer Focus:

Pray for faithfulness among God’s people:

1. There would be church-wide obedience in the tithe
2. God will raise up more members with the gift of giving
3. God’s blessing on our families and homes will be seen as a result of faithfulness in finances

Scripture:

“Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this,’ says the Lord Almighty, ‘and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it.’”

Malachi 3:10

Notes:

Day 17

Prayer Focus:

Pray that joyful giving becomes a hallmark of your worship to God. Ask the Holy Spirit to give you creative and effective ways to share what you have with others.

Scripture:

“Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.”

2 Corinthians 9:7

Notes:

Day 18

Prayer Focus:

Financial stewardship doesn't end with just being grateful. It is carried out by being radically generous. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you increase the measure you use to give to others from your money, attention, talents and skills, and knowledge.

Scripture:

“Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.”

Luke 6:38

Notes:

Day 19

Prayer Focus:

Pray that your truest treasure becomes the things of God and the things of the Spirit.

1. Pray that “the words of our mouths and the meditations of our hearts be acceptable in your sight.”
2. Pray that God blesses our finances so that we can bless others around us.
3. Ask the Holy Spirit to direct you to give to special projects that will make a Kingdom difference.

Scripture:

“For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.”

Matthew 6:21

Notes:

Day 20

Prayer Focus:

We are praying for increase

1. Praying for increase to give us more opportunities to bless others in our surrounding communities and nations abroad.
2. Increase in the number of people attending, so that we can have a larger pool of individuals to be able to accomplish more in the community.
3. Increase in all of the things that God has blessed us with so that we can be a blessing to others.

Scripture:

“Whoever oppresses the poor shows contempt for their Maker, but whoever is kind to the needy honors God.”

Proverbs 14:31

Notes:

“True Discipleship”

Day 21

Prayer Focus:

Pray for knowledge and wisdom so that we can pass on to others the things that we have learned.

1. Opportunities to share our story
2. Opportunities to reach others and bring more into the Kingdom of God

Scripture:

“And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrusted to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others.”

2 Timothy 2:2
